Religious Trials — JEWISH	FIRST	<i>John 18:12-14</i>	Annas	OK given to liquidate Jesus
	SECOND	<i>Matthew 26:57-68</i>	Caiaphas	Death sentence, charge of blasphemy
	THIRD	<i>Matthew 27:1-2</i>	Sanhedrin	Death sentence made legal
Civil Trials — ROMAN	FOURTH	<i>John 18:28-38</i>	Pilate	Not guilty
	FIFTH	<i>Luke 23:6-12</i>	Herod	Not guilty
	SIXTH	<i>John 18:39-19:6</i>	Pilate	Not guilty, but turned Jesus over to the Jews.
